Dear Sturgis Families,

I write to you today with an update and preview of some upcoming communications you can expect to receive from Sturgis. For clarity, I present these notes below via a numbered format:

- 1. In case you might have missed it, please see my <u>letter to families sent Friday, September 11th</u>.
- 2. The daily schedule $\frac{\text{next week } (9/21-9/25)}{\text{next week } (9/21-9/25)}$ is different from this past (first) week.
- 3. We ask that parents/guardians inform us electronically if your child will be absent, dismissed, or tardy from school (whether remote or in-person). You can find the <u>East</u> and <u>West</u> forms for sharing this information on our campus homepages.
- 4. Sturgis' co-curricular music and theatre programs will run this fall. Information will be forthcoming to students. For cleaning and efficiency purposes, we will use our West campus for all after-school arts programming for both East and West students.
- 5. Students will have two mask breaks when attending school in-person: at the end of second period and while eating their lunch. As a reminder, students are to bring their own lunch and carry it with them during the day.
- 6. Students are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle to school and use our hands-free bottle filling station.
- 7. On our <u>East</u> and <u>West</u> homepages, you can find a <u>technology help form</u> to report any glitches your Sturgis student may be experiencing with virtual learning.
- 8. Starting Monday, October 5th, our <u>529 Main building</u> will be available space permitting for students seeking a controlled and supervised setting during a remote learning day. Space will be limited to twenty students at first. I will share more details in my letter to you next Friday (9/25).

- 9. For students who have chosen to attend school completely remote, we will arrange for a books/materials pickup day in the coming weeks. We will communicate further details directly with those families next week.
- 10. Families may apply for free and reduced lunch services via <u>our online form.</u> Please note that eligible students also receive subsidized CCRTA passes and other school related costs (such as athletics fees).
- 11. As a reminder, you can submit inquiries <u>here</u> regarding back-to-school questions.
