Dear Sturgis Families,

I write to you today with an update and preview of some upcoming communications you can expect to receive from Sturgis. For clarity, I present these notes below via a numbered format:

- 1. In case you might have missed it, please see my letter to families sent <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 25th</u>.
- 2. Beginning next Friday, you will receive via email a campus-specific newsletter. I will send my weekly letter, as well, when I have information to share.
- 3. Next week, we will send you a digital copy of this year's student handbook. An electronic parent signature will be required. Details to follow.
- 4. Monday, October 12th is a federal holiday. There is no school that day (remote or in-person).
- 5. Families may apply for free and reduced lunch services via our <u>online form</u>. Please note that eligible students also receive subsidized CCRTA passes and other school related costs (such as athletics fees, cap and gown fee, college application fees, and college admission testing fees).
- 6. Wednesdays are asynchronous learning days. Students should be working independently on their assignments throughout the day, and taking advantage of teacher office hours and club meeting times. To be clear, Wednesday is a school day (not an off-day nor a work-at-my-job day).
