This morning, I met with our COVID-related steering committee. During our meeting, we analyzed how all of the local and state data for important COVID metrics have worsened over the past seven days.

As a result, their unanimous recommendation was that we remain fully remote for next week. After reflecting on the reasoning presented in that discussion, I am sharing with you that we will be fully remote for the week beginning January 19th. This includes both normal school programming and co-curricular programming.

The ability to attend school in-person is key for students, and I hope that we can return to that preferred reality very soon. Please do use the nurses' symptom reporting form to help inform our future decision-making.

I will share next Friday our plan for the following week. As a reminder, Monday, January 18th is Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, a federal holiday, and classes will not meet.
