Test and Stay program:

Please note- there is no cost to families to participate in this program.

Families who wish to take part in the Test and Stay program (if deemed necessary) must first register their student with the state's testing provider, CIC Health. We encourage all families to register their children as soon as possible. Families should follow these steps:

1. Log on to the [CIC Health](#) website.
 2. Click on "Consent Now".
 3. Select Sturgis Charter Public School as the school district.
 4. Select the appropriate campus.
 5. For students under 18, select "Sign Consent for a Minor" and enter the appropriate demographic information.
 6. Students 18 and over must select "Consent for Yourself" due to HIPPA regulations.
- Families are encouraged to provide assistance for these students.

Sturgis is only participating in the Test and Stay program. We are not participating in Pooled Testing.

The English Learner Education (ELE) department is pleased to announce that Sturgis will be offering the Massachusetts State Seal of Biliteracy to students! The State Seal of Biliteracy is an award that recognizes high school graduates who attain high functional and academic levels of proficiency in English and another world language, in recognition of students having studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages.
