***Why participate in the 4Cs Pathways
program?***

Students who attend the meeting on February 2
will be part of the Pathways program. Although
you can apply to 4Cs at any point, the Pathways
program has benefits including:

- *On the spot interviews:* these virtual one-on-one personal interviews will give students an opportunity to meet with their assigned 4Cs admissions counselor to review their application, ask questions, and get additional support through the enrollment process.
- *Early registration:* Pathways students are eligible to register for classes two weeks earlier than other first-time students, giving them more class choices.
- *Financial Aid Assistance:* Personalized financial aid assistance during virtual drop-in hours.
- *Pathways Scholarship:* One Sturgis student will be awarded a \$4,000 Pathways Scholarship.

Have your student speak to their school
counselor if they have questions.
